The launch of Sparrows Nest enables us to radically challenge and revolutionize the norms of “orphan care” and to raise the standards of what has previously been considered “acceptable” when caring for the vulnerable. This site will bring best-in-class care, eternity-minded staff, top-tier academics, and high quality facilities all to one site. When

combined, it will allow us to raise up kingdom warriors empowered to lead for generations to come and to train other organizations to do the same!

We see each child in our family as a child of His, with the potential to make an eternal kingdom impact! Our mission is greater than merely rescuing the forgotten—it is to shepherd them for life—towards a deeper understanding of their God-given gifts and abilities so that they may achieve all that God has made them capable of. Best-in-Class Academics Beginning June 2017

Offering curriculum taught entirely in English, the PreK-12th grade school will offer top-notch academics to prepare our daughters for the best colleges in India and internationally. During this initial phase of construction we'll complete eight classrooms, sufficient for grades PreK-6, with additional classrooms to be built in the future. Key administrators and teachers are being interviewed now. Classes are set to begin June 2017.




Premiere Staff-Training Facilities

Quality office space and conference rooms allow us to train our staff and the staff at partner orphanages. Equipped with video-conference rooms that facilitate teaching from the U.S., a library with in-depth resources, and comfortable overnight accommodations for guests, this site allows us to share our knowledge and expand our replication model to other group homes in India and beyond.

Fewer than 1% of Indian students attend this caliber of school.



10 people on staff will have Master's Degrees in Child Development, care for our daughters, and train others.





Family-Style Housing Opening April 2017

Small, family-style homes are being built to encourage family-bonding and individuality. Each child will have personal study and quiet space with just 12 children per home. The grounds allow for additional homes to be built in future years as our family grows.

Sports and Creativity Facilities

Leadership skills and perseverance are oftentimes learned through competition and creative pursuits. Both athletic and artistic gifts will be developed with on-site facilities including a sports track, tennis courts, volleyball nets, basketball courts, a playground, and an amphitheater for dances, drama, speech competitions, and musical performances.

Better Care for More Children, Today

The plight of many orphanages in India

With more than 20 million orphans and thousands of orphanages operating in India, the opportunity to replicate our model is nearly endless. A critical need for many of these orphanages is the staff training and financial resources to improve their care. Oftentimes facilities are run-down, a single caregiver may have 30 children to care for, staff is overworked and un-trained, and educational opportunities are limited. A child-marriage, a \$1/day job, or worse is “success,” though the end-result is a vicious cycle of abuse, neglect, and poverty for generation-upon-generation.

250+ additional children impacted through Replication

Four group homes in our communities have asked for As Our Own to guide their operations by managing their facilities, training their staff, overseeing their care programs, and improving the school their children attend. They’ve seen the achievements of our daughters and want the same for their children, but they don’t have the financial resources or the knowledge to turn it around themselves. Through these four sites we’ll be able to care for boys and girls, impacting an additional 250+ children this year!




\$6,138 PER YEAR TO CARE FOR ONE DAUGHTER

It is our hope and prayer that the Lord will provide for this expansion through our supporters, including you!
